We have heard directly from Fr Joseph of the civil unrest in Bamenda which has been ongoing now for nearly 12 months, and reference to these difficulties was made by Fr Bonaventure at his recent Farewell Mass. Catholic schools have been closed for a long period, and many of the priests have not been paid their allowances since last A few parishioners, on their own initiative, have contributed whatever their can afford – in cash – and the money is being kept in the Parish Office. If anyone would like to add to this fund, please place your cash in an envelope marked Fr Joseph - Bamenda, and post it through the letter box in the Parish Office. Fr Bonaventure has kindly agreed to take whatever amount is collected with him when he returns to Bamenda on 1st August, and he will pass it on to Fr Joseph.
