FIRST HOLY COMMUNION PROGRAMME 2017/18

If your child is in Year 3 or above, you are invited to collect an Enrolment Form and a Parental Consent form from the Church porch or, for convenience, from St Paul's School office. 8 DAY PILGRIMAGE TO ROME & <u>SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO</u>

In Rome, we will visit Basilica of St Mary Major, Basilica of St John Lateran, Trevi Fountain name but a few and of course the Vatican for a guided tour. In St Giovanni Rotondo, the visits will include the tomb of St Pio, a tour of the sanctuary, view the crucifix where St Pio received the stigmata and the Grotto of St Michael the Archangel. Pilgrimage dates: Monday, 15th October 2018 – Monday, 22nd October 2018. The cost will be £991 per person based on minimum of 30 persons. Single room supplement is £240 per person. REMINDER: DROP IN CENTRE AND PARISH SVP
