Applicants aged – 24 and wishing to help with a 16 Catholic/Christian project at home or abroad or as a helper on a trip to Lourdes or helping HCPT (Hosanna House and Children's Pilgrimage Trust), the Bursary fund may be able to contribute to your expenses. Bursary Grants awarded according to the merits of each individual application with a contribution of £45 for helpers in Lourdes and £75 for HCPT helpers. Bursary Awards for those on projects are of £150 and upwards depending on the duration of the project, plus meeting additional criteria, e.g. a minimum of 15 days working on a project.
