Statement from CAFOD: Like you, CAFOD is deeply disturbed by the ongoing attacks on Ukraine. Together, we stand in solidarity with the Ukrainian people and send our prayers to our sister organisation, Caritas Ukraine, and those Caritas agencies in neighbouring countries, who are already helping people affected by this conflict.

Recent fundraising activities at St Joseph's have already raised around £3,000, which was donated to the CAFOD Ukraine appeal. From this weekend, there will be an additional basket in the porch for donations. Fr Peter will hand these donations personally to a Parish Priest contact in Poland, when he visits at the end of April, who is directly helping a parish in Ukraine.
