THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD (C) - SUNDAY, 13TH JANUARY 2019



Today, we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, bringing the season of Christmas to an end. Jesus was baptised by John the Baptist in the River Jordan. At His baptism, the Holy Spirit descended on Him and the voice of the Father was heard from heaven, "You are my Son, the Beloved; my favour rests on you." From this point onwards, Jesus began his work of teaching, healing, forgiving and proclaiming the Good News of the kingdom of God.

This is an opportunity for us all to reflect on our own baptism and what it means. Baptism is the beginning of our journey as Christians; as followers of Jesus. It marks the beginning of our belonging to the church, which is completed with the Sacrament of Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and Confirmation.
