FIRE DRILL

The fire drills carried out at the 8.30 am and 10.30 am Masses on last Sunday, 4th August went very well. The evacuation was achieved in about 90 seconds at both Masses. A meeting was held on Monday morning to assimilate comments from the wardens and review feedback from both congregations. As a result, there is a list of actions the team will be working on to improve fire safety. We are now committed to annual fire drills with the 2020 drill taking place at a different time of year to assess the impact of different weather conditions and perhaps larger congregations.
