TALK ON JOHN HENRY NEWMAN

By Fr Michael Sharkey at St Anne's, Southview Avenue, Caversham, RG4 5AB, on Monday, 21st October at 7.30 pm. Newman was the leader of the Oxford Movement which led him to be received into the Catholic Church by Blessed Dominic Barberi on 9th October 1845. He was the founder of Oratorium Congregation. His theological writings have had a profound influence on the Catholic Church. We are pleased that Fr Michael is to share his knowledge on Newman with us and recommend this evening as a time for the Reading parishes to celebrate a new English Saint.
