Who he is, we see in this Sunday's Gospel, is best understood by who he isn't. John prepares the way for the Lord. His baptism is symbolic, not sacramental. It is a sign given to stir our hearts to repentance. John comes to us in the Advent readings to show us the light, that we might believe in the One who comes at Christmas.
