GOING INTO HOSPITAL?

If you know in advance that you are going into hospital, please inform Fr Peter. In case of emergency, inform hospital staff and they will contact a priest for you. Sunday Mass is celebrated at 4 pm in the Royal Berkshire Hospital chapel. *Patients, staff & visitors are all welcome*.

GENERAL HEALTH ISSUES (CORONAVIRUS)

You are no doubt aware of the risk to health of the Coronavirus (also known as Covid 19). Until further notice, we are taking the following measures:

- There will be no holy water in the stoops
- Communion is of one kind only (no Precious Blood)
- The host will only be placed directly into your hand (not on the tongue)
- The Sign of Peace is to be 'non-contact'. You may wish each other peace without touching
- The weekly collection baskets will be taken around rather than passed around.

HAND HYGIENE IS VITAL - You are welcome to bring your own hand sanitiser, as we are having trouble buying hand sanitizer at the moment, as stocks are scarce. The toilet handbasins have hot water, soap and paper hand towels for you to use. To disrupt the spread of the virus: *Catch it - sneeze into a tissue. Bin it - bin the tissue. Kill it - wash your hands.*

Please be aware that the Diocese and the Parish are constantly reviewing our approach to health and hygiene to minimise the risk of spreading this virus.

PILGRIMAGE TO MEDIUGORIE

If you would like to consider travelling to Medjugorje as a parish, please add your name and telephone number to Fr Peter's list. Details are set out below:

16th - 25th September 2020 - 9 nights. Accommodation is based on bed, breakfast and evening meal. All rooms are en-suite and air conditioned. Tariff: Single occupancy: 35 Euros per night = 315 Euros per person. Shared occupancy: 25 Euros per night = 225 Euros per person. (Note: any possible increase on these rates in due course will be very minimal). Also, there will be an additional total return payment of 40 Euros per person for coach transfers between the airport and Medjugorje. Flight details: Outbound: BA0842 LHR - SPLIT (Terminal 5) departing at 13.35 – 16th September 2020. Return: BA0843 SPLIT - LHR (Terminal 5) departing at 14.20 - 25th September 2020.



Please note that there is a designated wheelchair area in our church, situated beside the choir.

LENT 2020

Traditionally, Lent has been a time when we give up something we enjoy: biscuits, sweets or alcohol, for example. However, Lent is about self-discipline. Self-discipline doesn't have to be "giving something up", it can take the form of "doing something extra". During Lent last year, Fr Peter introduced a 6.30 am Mass on Wednesday mornings, giving us all the opportunity to practise self-discipline - to do something extra. The last of these Masses will be on 1st April (there will not be one in Holy Week). This Holy Season of Lent, why not give it a go? It really is good for the soul.

THE RE-DEDICATION OF ENGLAND AS THE DOWRY OF MARY – "BEHOLD"

This Re-dedication on March 29th is both a personal promise by the people of England, and a renewal of the entrustment vows made by King Richard II in Westminster Abbey in 1381. England received the title 'Mary's Dowry' when Richard sought Our Lady's protection in the face of great political turmoil. This meant England was 'set aside' as a gift for Our Lady under her guidance and protection. On Sunday, 29th March at 12 noon, the Re-dedication will take place throughout the country. Like King Richard we are invited to give ourselves, the people of this country, as a gift to Mary. We can respond in two ways; making a personal pledge (the "Angelus Promise" in which we proclaim our union with Mary through the words of the Annunciation) and a communal entrustment (a prayer of profoundly historic and spiritual nature, bringing together the prayers of surrender and dedication that have echoed throughout our history). All parishes, schools and Catholic organisations are invited to host this dedication and mark the occasion in their own way. For more details go to
